




Our Mission - To deliver targeted programs including 1:1 peer support recovery coaching, healthy replacement activities and group counseling, education and support to at-risk teens and young adults (ages13-25) who are at risk of substance misuse, substance use and/or mental health challenges, and are striving to attain and maintain sobriety and stable mental health, in a safe, healthy manner.



Nate's Story





Nate's Place was founded in memory of Nate Rhoades, who sadly passed away at the age of 21 after a car accident on January 20, 2022. Nate had recovered from addiction 5 years prior and supported others.

Statement of Need in Ventura County



Substance Use Disorders

Opioid Crisis

Mental Health

- SUDs most prevalent among ages 18-25 (2x the state rate in Ventura County)
- In CA, in 2019, 20.7% of people 12-25 had an SUD
- In 2022, over 200 Ventura County residents died from an opioid drug overdose (33% increase from 2021)
- That year the VC Opioid Abuse Suppression Task
 Force declared a Public Health Crisis

- During the pandemic, 37% of high school students experienced poor mental health
- Depression expected to be #1 cause of disability by 2030

Gap in Services



- No other programs exist in Ventura County that incorporate 1:1 Peer Support Recovery Coaching, 20+ Healthy Recreational Activities & Group Counseling, Education & Group Support.
- Limited accessibility for low income and/or MediCal participants, limited services.
- Most of treatment for those with SUD/Cooccurring disorders is for adults, with private pay/insurance other than MediCal.
- Teens and young adults are Most Susceptible to Peer Influence
- Transportation and cost are huge barriers.



- Assist in identifying at least 2 healthy activities each week




Teen Intervene Groups

- Successfully completed 4 rounds of Teen Intervene (T.I.) Group (4 weeks) at Legacy High School in Ojai.
- Completed 1 round of Teen Intervene at Pacific High School in Ventura.
- **30 Participants** were very engaged; benefitted from group.
- 3 Nate's Place Peer Coaches trained on Teen Intervene.



Nate's Place Works - Data & Positive Outcomes



Current Participant Data (Changes over time)

- > 53.4% of Participants are Hispanic; 8.2% are bi-racial, 6.8% Filipino, 6.8% Black
- > 78% are Teens; 22% are Young Adults (TAY)
- > 5/12 Staff are Bilingual (English and Spanish Speaking)
- > 53% Male Participants; 40% Female Participants; 7% are Transgender

Current Outcomes of Many Participants

- ➤ 66% improvement in mental health of participants
- > Reduced substance use among participants; some abstinent.
- > Improved grades, fewer fights at school, reduced suspensions.
- > Stabilized mental health, improved relationships with family and friends.
- > Some of TAY participants have gotten jobs, starting college.


